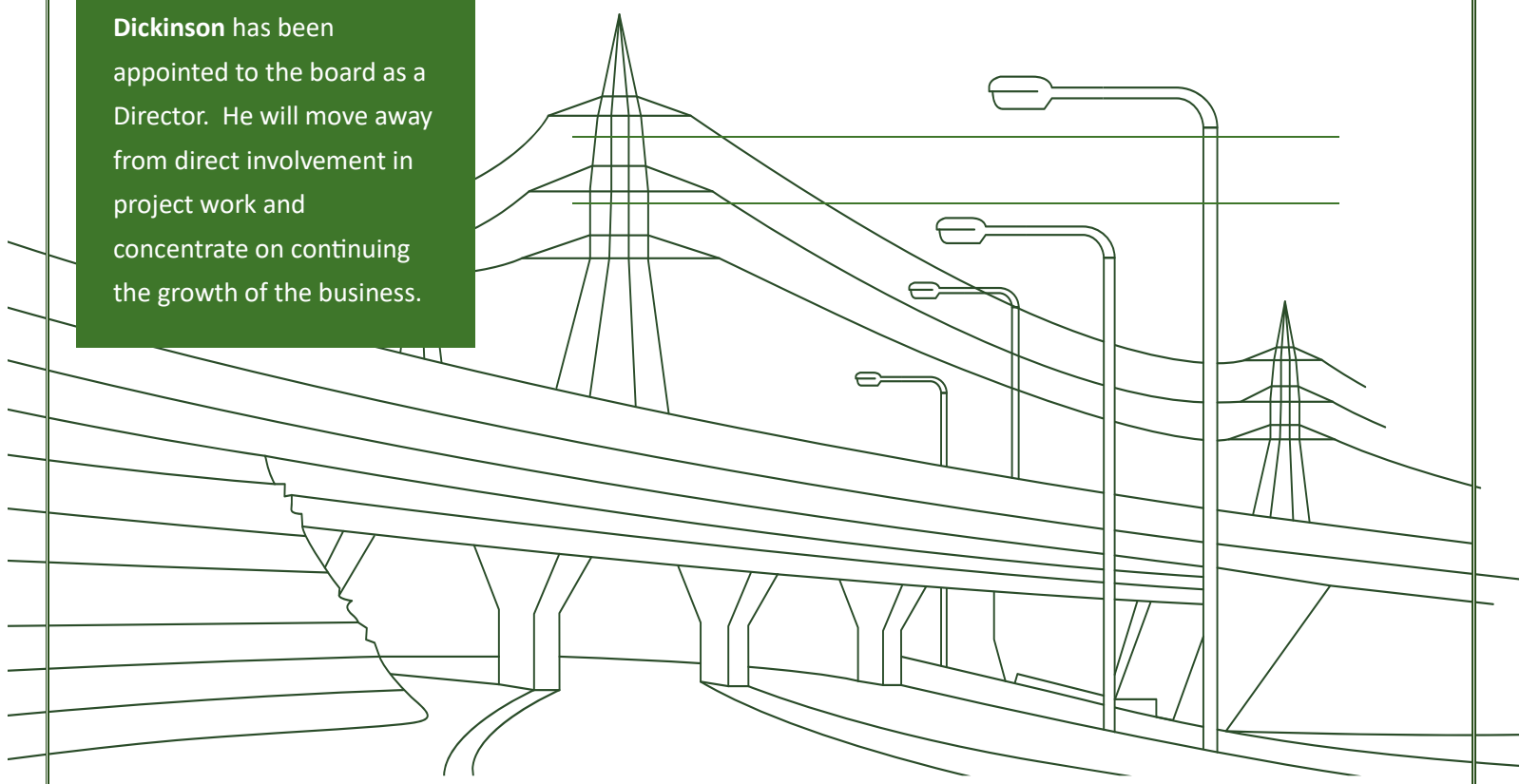
Welcome to our fourth newsletter and the first for 2019, where we look forward to another busy and fruitful year.

IN OTHER NEWS.....

- GeoCon continues to undertake flood alleviation site investigation work, adding Hebden Bridge and Hull to the locations we have now investigated for Mott Macdonald / EA.
- Directional drilling continues to be a growing industry sector, GeoCon is now the contractor of choice for two of the largest HDD companies, almost exclusively providing the pre-start ground condition reports in the north of the country.
